### Individual

Individual membership is open for judges, court managers and administrators, clerks of court, law students, and other related professionals. Membership dues are based on a tiered system, through an established sliding scale linked to public sector salaries in each country.

### Organizational

Organizational members include two types:

1. Regular organizational memberships are available to associations, NGO's, international organizations and courts (domestic and international) that are engaged with court administration / management.
2. Associate organizational memberships will be available to (i) prospective sponsors such as rule corporations, government agencies and independent foundations that sponsor grants for rule of law related initiatives; and (ii) rule of law contractors and NGOs that solicit grants to sponsor rule of law projects with goals similar to IACA's.
